What is considered as Personal Data?

Personal data means any information related to an identified or identifiable natural person

- Names / Surnames
- Emails / Phone numbers
- Passport / Tax IDs
- IP / MAC addresses
- Logins and passwords
- And many others

What is PortaOne's role under GDPR?

The roles of PortaOne and its customers:

- CSP – data controller
- PortaOne – data processor
- End-user – data subject

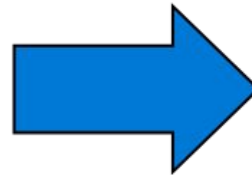

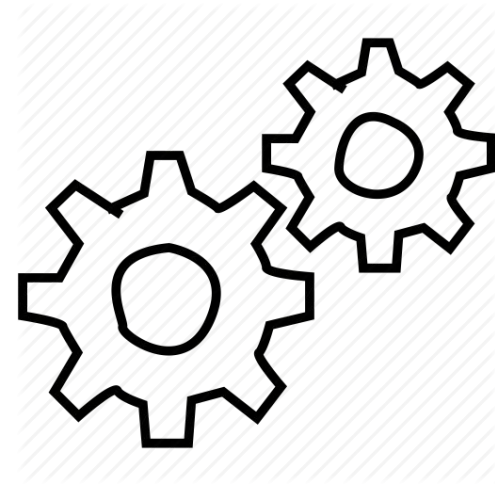
What to do to comply?
